

Ripplezoo Cameroon Financial Report January 2020

The work completed and achievements

On November 23rd, 2019, 9 volunteers travelled to Cameroon, some had been last year and some going for the first time. As a result of the kind donations and support from so many, we were able to achieve the following:

- €500,000 of medical equipment, beds, prescription medicine and other supplies were distributed to hospitals in Batoufam & Fum boot. This year we were in a position to offer wheelchairs and crutches to people in the community, some who have been unable to leave their homes for years.
- The complete renovation of 3 additional classrooms; new floors, plastered walls (interior and exterior), new windows, walkway outside the classrooms and the 3 classrooms painted and decorated. Over our 2 years there, the primary school of Batoufam now have 6 renovated classrooms accommodating over 150 primary school children.
- We also worked with the locals digging a large trench to direct water away from the school, as it floods during the rainy season and keeps the school closed for prolonged spells.
- At École publique Famla, Batoufam, 122 very grateful and excited primary school children received a set of schoolbooks for the first time.
- The water supply we installed last year in the hospital has been a wonderful success bringing clean water and sanitation. Such is the quality of the water that all the locals come there for their water. The water pump required replacing & upgrading.
- The Multimedia Center / Computer room is open to the schools and community and we will continue to fund its operational costs through 2020.
- Hundreds of orphans received mattresses, wheelchairs and clothes. We left toys for the children to open at Christmas.
- And once again, hundreds of Cameroonian people who have so little and suffer terribly, once again know that there are people in the world who love and care for them.
